All sexual acts may lead to a transmission of diseases. Condoms are the best protection against HIV/AIDS.

That is why it makes sense, to regularly have yourself examined as most diseases are easy to treat.

## Your job is not always easy

In your job you may be subject to prejudice, exploitation, violence or coercion. Sometimes help is needed or a conversation with a person who does not judge you or demand explanations.

- \* We can organize an interpreter, please advise beforehand.
- \* We also offer advice to you on site or at
- your working place or carry out a training for you and your colleagues.

You may speak openly with us. We do not judge. We do not control.



# EXAMINATION

- \* of health problems and medical prevention of sexually transmitted infections
- \* Examination for HIV/AIDS and sexually transmitted infections (e.g. hepatitis A, B, C, syphillis, chlamydia, clap/gonorrhoea)
- Treatment of sexually transmitted infections if necessary; transfer to specialised facilities for treatment
- \* Vaccination against Hepatitis A and B

## <u>ADVICE</u>

# \* Advice around the topic of sex work,

- e. g. concerning (sexual) health, contraception, intimate hygiene, security and protection at your working place, on your rights in Germany, dealings with public authorities, finance, counselling on entry and exit
- \* Accompanied visits, e.g. to doctors, public institutions and offices
- \* Help and support, e.g. with social or psychological
- problems, addiction, debts, (sexualised) violence or coercion.
- \* Transfer to other facilities, counselling offices and doctors.
