The City of Leipzig and the regional development agency Aufbauwerk Region Leipzig GmbH invite you to attend the European Academy on Urban Regeneration **Leipzig manual – New Strategies for Cities**.

Leipzig manual offers the opportunity to exchange experiences and to discuss new strategies in urban regeneration with European partners. Key aspects of the Academy will be innovative strategic approaches on how to include private property owners in the process of urban regeneration and how to create revolving investment funds for urban development projects. We want to evaluate the experiences with such instruments up to now. Further more, we want to discuss from a City's perspective conclusions in regard to the coming EU Programming Period 2014 – 2020.

Leipzig manual combines two current European projects, where Leipzig is lead partner and partner city. Both partner meetings of these projects are interlinked and therefore opened to a broader audience.

The Academy is composed of three modules:

Module 1

EPOurban-Academy

The EPOurban-Academy is a platform of the CENTRAL EUROPE project EPOurban - Enabling Private Owners of Residential Buildings to Integrate them into Urban Restructuring Processes (www.epourban.eu). Core of the Academy is the exchange of new experiences with interdisciplinary consulting services for private property owners, which have been implemented in each EPOurban partner city. Presentations, workshops and excursions will focus on specific consulting issues. This module is regarded as further training for consultants from the EPOurban partner cities. Module 2

URBACT-Network meeting CSI Europe

The URBACT-Network CSI Europe – City Sustainable Investment in Europe (www.urbact.eu/ en/projects/metropolitan-governance/csi-europe) examines the implementation and further development of Urban Development Funds (UDF). The Network meeting in Leipzig concentrates on the topic of technical assistance for cities in order to start an UDF. The first results of an international case study launched by CSI will be presented. Module 3

EU-Forum New Strategies for Cities

The European Union offers multiple support for cities and helps them to develop innovative strategies and instruments for urban regeneration. Partner cities of various European projects implement and test these new strategies. In return these cities can contribute their experiences and recommend necessary adjustments to the European regional development policy. The EU-Forum will therefore discuss the instruments of the EU Programming Period 2014 – 2020 and their impact on urban development.
